From October 1, 2018 until January 15, 2019, young researchers not older than 35 years, with an advanced degree, are invited to apply for the Eppendorf Award for Young European Investigators 2019. This award was established in 1995 and is presented in partnership with the scientific journal *Nature*. It acknowledges outstanding contributions to biomedical research in Europe based on methods of molecular biology, including novel analytical concepts.


The winner receives a **prize money of 20,000 EUR** and wide coverage of his/her research by *Nature* in print and online media, including a podcast. The Award prize ceremony takes place at the EMBL Advanced Training Centre in Heidelberg, Germany.

The **independent Eppendorf Award Jury** chaired by Prof. Reinhard Jahn (Max Planck Institute for Biophysical Chemistry, Göttingen, Germany) is especially looking for creative talents who work independently with a strong focus on translating their research into practical findings for human medicine. This year's winner was the immunologist Dr. Andrea Ablasser, Assistant Professor at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology, Lausanne, Switzerland.
