Dear students,

Last week on Friday you received the information pack about new requirements of optional subjects of Department of Physical Education. The email was sent from Study Department 2nd FM, CU.

We immediately received questions from some of you, whether you can still register for optional subjects of our department.

There is still a possibility to enrol in optional subject Physical Education until 16th of November 2020 or in Winter Sport Courses by an email.

Physical Education is a two-semester course. You can still register for this subject through Study Department. If you decide to do so, you have to complete the first part of requirements from winter semester distantly as you can see in instructions in previous document (STRAVA.com, 8 times chosen activity or testing of physical abilities during spring months). We believe there will be practical lessons allowed in summer semester and we can see each other in person and do sports together in normal mode. As the second part of credit requirements, you would choose particular sport in our web application according to the schedule for summer semester and attend it. You will be informed about registration process in time. In case of other restrictions in spring, we will inform you about distant form of additional requirements when it is up to date.

The optional subject Winter sports course must be registered in SIS and then choose the particular option here (here - first seven options or by email). If the winter sport courses could not be held, an alternative program will be organized or another kind of way for completing the credit in a distant form will be created.

It is no longer possible to register for other courses in the winter semester, but you can enrol in optional subjects – sports semestral courses, taught only during the summer semester, via SIS in the week from 8th to 12th February 2021.
