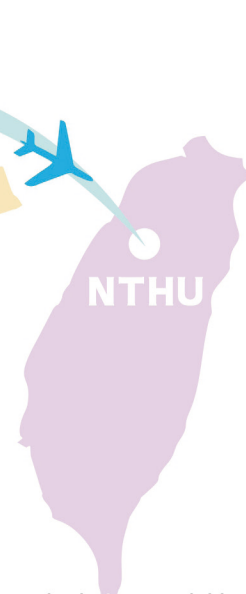

“Guidelines for Taiwan-Europe Connectivity Scholarship”



Purpose

Ministry of Foreign Affairs Taiwan (MOFA) offers designated Taiwan-Europe Connectivity Scholarship for international students whose nationality are Czech Republic to exchange or pursue their study in National Tsing Hua University (NTHU). The scholarship aims to encourage outstanding international students to study in Taiwan, as well as to promote bilateral exchanges and friendship between the peoples of Taiwan and Czech Republic.

Numbers of Scholarship recipients

We are offering Scholarship to total eight (8) students to study in NTHU, preferably from following partner universities:

- a、 Charles University: 2 students
- b、 University of Chemistry and Technology Prague: 2 students
- c、 Czech Technical University in Prague: 2 students
- d、 Masaryk University: 2 students

Coverage of the scholarship

Scholarship recipients will be given a monthly stipend of 800 USD (NT\$25,000) for exchange/degree programs. Recipients are responsible for all expenses during their stay in Taiwan. MOFA will not provide any other subsidies. MOFA will, however, provide recipients with 2 one-way

economy-class plane tickets for direct flights to and from Taiwan. Besides from the monthly stipend, NTHU also offers tuition waiver to students receiving the scholarship.

Eligibility Criteria

- a、 High school graduates or above with excellent academic records and good moral character and have no criminal record.
- b、 Prospective exchange students or degree students who are Czech Republic citizens. (not a national of the Republic of China (Taiwan) / an overseas compatriot student.) Prospective Ph.D. students are preferred.
- c、 Have strong academic credentials in specific academic fields.
- d、 Have never attended an educational institution in Taiwan at the same level of degree.
- e、 Have not previously had a Scholarship revoked by an Taiwan government agency or other relevant institutions.

Terms and Conditions for Recipients

- a、 Exchange/Degree programs: Recipients apply for admission to any exchange or degree program leading to an undergraduate, master or doctoral degree, excluding in-service programs. Students joining these programs should take at least 1 Chinese learning course (2 credits) each semester at Mandarin-teaching institutions (hereinafter "Mandarin Training Centers") in NTHU. This does not include cultural visits, speeches,

and other self-learning curriculum or activities.

- b、 The recipient can concurrently receive scholarships from other sources during their placement in this scholarship program.
- c、 The termination and cancellation of a scholarship is based on regulations specified by NTHU. NTHU have the right to terminate or revoke a scholarship if the recipient's academic performance, moral character, or attendance record is not up to NTHU's standards.
- d、 Recipients of a six month or longer scholarship are obligated to join the National Health Insurance Program in Taiwan. Before joining, recipients should purchase student accident insurance and other relevant insurance. Insurance fees can be deducted by the NTHU from the monthly stipend before granting it to recipients.
- e、 Scholarship funding will become effective on the date of the recipient's enrollment. Scholarship funding will end on the scholarship's expiration date or if the scholarship is revoked.
- f、 If recipients fail to come to Taiwan for enrollment during the designated time, they will forfeit their right to retain their scholarships.
