

Updated Rules of the Entrance Examination Procedure for the Academic Year 2020/2021

M5103 General Medicine – Kmenový obor: Všeobecné lékařství (PS)

Maximum number of accepted students: 90

Length of study: 6 years

Possibility of exemption from entrance examination: No

Application type: Paper, Online

Characteristics of the field: The Second Faculty of Medicine offers a six-year full-time MD study programme in General Medicine.

Entrance examination terms: 1–4 June 2020

Description of verification and evaluation criteria:

Entrance examination: The entrance examination will take place in distance form online. A three-member committee will be present during the examination procedure and the applicants will be interviewed concerning student motivation including one question related to ethical aspects of medicine. Furthermore, the examination will be completed by an interview on topics from biology, chemistry and physics.

Conditions for admission: For admission to Master's studies, students must have completed their secondary education, confirmed by their graduation certificate. Admission to Post-Bachelor studies (Master's programme) is likewise conditional upon a completed education in any type of study programme.
