## **Applicant Requirements:**

- University education in general medicine
- Scientific-pedagogical degree of professor, associate professor or prerequisite for its achievement within 2 years
- Academic title of DrSc., CSc., or PhD.
- Specialised competence in the field of Infectious Medicine
- Min. 10 years of experience in the field
- teaching experience from a medical university and readiness to guarantee fieldspecific subjects which are taught at the department
- Personal and professional prerequisites for the running of the academic team of the department
- Research and publishing activity in the field
- Active knowledge of English and Czech language required

Applications, along with photocopies of documentation on education, curriculum vitae, work history overview, overview of scientific and publishing activities, certificate pursuant to Section 4 (1) of Act No. 451/1991 Coll. together with an affidavit pursuant to Section 4 (3) of Act No. 451/1991 Coll. Furthermore, the application should include a written piece on the concept of the workplace – maximum three pages, proof of a clean criminal record (not older than 3 months) and at least 2 written references.
